The following memo serves to provide an update to PSOs and their membership regarding the operations of Weightlifting Canada Haltérophilie (WCH).

1. Canadian Invitational:

Rooms:

We have secured the Don Valley Inn as the competition hotel. The rates are as follows

- Single Occupancy: \$150/night (all taxes included)
- Double Occupancy: \$75/night/person (all taxes included)
- Parking is available on site but not included in the rates provided.

The deadline for any changes to the original submissions is Monday February 1, 2022, at 4pm Mountain time.

Payment:

PSO's will be invoiced for all expenses related to their registered athletes, coaches, support personnel. Invoices will be sent prior to February 5th, 2022.

Registration fees have been set at \$200 for athletes and \$150 for coaches.

Any athlete, coach, support personnel that cancels their registration or makes changes to their accommodations after Monday February 1, 2022 will be responsible for the charges incurred.

Full payment is due by February 20th, 2022. Participation is not guaranteed if payment is not received by the cut-off date.

2. Competition Development Coach Evaluations

In light of the challenges of COVID and recognizing the backlog of coaches requiring evaluations to advance from NCCP Competition Introduction to NCCP Competition Development, the Board of Directors has resolved that Evaluations for coaches to advance from NCCP Competition Introduction to NCCP Competition Development can take place at the following competitions in 2022:

- 2022 Canadian Invitational (Scarborough, ON)
- 2022 Canadian Senior Weightlifting Championships (Kelowna, BC)
- 2022 North American Open (Calgary, AB)
- 2022 Canadian Junior Weightlifting Championships (TBD)

Taking this step recognizes the need to develop and evaluation more coaches at the competition Development level to help grow the sport. This is an amendment to the existing practice on NCCP Competition Development evaluations.

3. Coach Selection Policy
