RE: Updates and Information

A. Minimum Threshold of Performance and Standards

The initial meeting of the high-performance committee occurred earlier this month. The decision was made to extend the current Minimum Threshold of Performance for International Team Qualification through to June 2023. This will allow for any new standards to be aligned with the AAP program such that there will only be one set of standards for athletes to gauge their performance. The New AAP standards will be released in January 2023 following the Senior World Championships.

Further to the extension of the MTP for international team selection, the markers for junior and senior national championships will not change until July 2023 as well.

B. Call for Proposals for Junior and Senior Nationals for 2023 and 2024

WCH is seeking proposals from PSO's wishing to host our Junior and/or Senior Nationals for the next 2 years. A specific list of information required is provided at the end of this memo and all questions must be answered as part of the submission process. Proposals are due on or before November 26, 2022. As a reminder, the 2023 Junior Nationals are to take place in June.

C. Safe Sport and Participation in the Office of the Sport Integrity Commissioner Program

Weightlifting Canada was one of the first 2 NSOs to sign up for the OSIC program. We are committed to ensuring a safe environment for all participants in our sport, and we will continue to explore ways to better ensure athletes and the integrity of our sport are protected whether at home or abroad.

D. NEW POLICY - Screening Policy

In alignment with best practice, WCH has passed a new policy regarding background screening requirements for any person working with or volunteering for Weightlifting Canada Haltérophilie.
