NOTICE OF CHANGE ATHLETE WEIGH IN RULE

WCH previously implemented an amendment to the TCRR to require all athletes to weigh-in wearing their singlet. A 300g allowance was afforded for the weight of the singlet at that time.

WCH has rescinded that amendment and is supporting the TCRR rules as written for Weigh-in procedures. Full details can be found on the IWF website.

Regulation TO 6.4 is where the applicable section will be found.

Updates from Board Meeting

Monthly Board of Directors Meeting was held on October 29th. The following is a brief summary of key items discussed:

Election of Officers and Director Portfolios (previous page)

Hosting International Events: The board has decided to express interest to host the 2025 IWF World Junior Championships. A recent funding announcement for international events makes the potential of hosting possible. Preliminary intent was submitted on November 2, 2023. Proceeding to the next stage will depend on confirmation of government support for hosting the event, which support is not guaranteed. The preliminary stage of this process does not require a financial commitment by WCH. Given the financial commitments required to host IWF events, bidding on a 2026 event may be more feasible.

WCH currently relies on its **Equity, Diversity and Inclusion policy** and is awaiting further details from the IWF on their Transgender Policy. The IWF Policy is in effect but not currently available to the public. Once the IWF makes the policy available, the Board will discuss the approach for WCH.

Pan American Weightlifting Development Project: WCH is supporting a Caribbean training camp and competition in Barbados. The PAWF has selected coach Rachel Siemens to attend the training camp as a coach. Multiple athletes from Canada are also attending the events.

NCCP Evaluation Procedure: The Coaching Development Committee submitted a draft proposal to the Board on an updated NCCP Coach Evaluation Procedure. The matter was discussed at length and an updated version of the proposal will go before the Board at its November meeting.

A new mechanism to register for coach evaluation will be released soon!

National Championship Growth

Recovering from COVID has been challenging for many provinces. Each year since we have been able to resume our National Championships we have grown in size at both the Junior and Senior Levels.

National Championship Updates

Senior Nationals: This competition will take place from May 17-19th in Halifax, Nova Scotia at the Halifax Convention Centre. The regulation for this event will be released soon.

Junior Nationals: This competition will take place in Toronto at the Variety Village Community Centre. The proposed dates are June 15-16. If PSOs have any questions or concerns about the proposed dates due to high school final exams or other factors, please contact the OWA to discuss.

The qualification period for each event started on August 1, 2023. Provinces are welcome to choose which competitions serve as qualification events for their provincial teams.

WCH will release an expression of interest package for PSO's to consider hosting future National Championships in the near future.
