Updates from the Board

The second PSO quarterly meeting was held on June 9th. Topics discussed included schedule for next meetings, selection of hosts for Nationals, upcoming international competitions, status of ITO registration, process for new record recognition, and fundraising activities .

Update provided on fundraising activities by Kathy Johnston. She is working with Quinn Everett to put together sponsorship packages. They are refining the information and have recently met with someone from USAW to understand how they have been successful with their approach.

The technical official committee had its second meeting. The key priorities for them are the national pathway and review of the TCRR.

The Anti-doping portfolio reported many new people added to the National Athlete Pool as a result of Nationals. 100% of registered athletes have taken the necessary training.

Athletes council reported that they are working on a ranking tool for athletes to see how they are ranked in all categories and how they stand for National and International qualification.

The first Gender equity meeting was held in Halifax. Two initiatives will be coming forward soon—a virtual symposium for female leaders and another round of technical official development for women looking to be involved.
