

NOMINATIONS COMMITTEE TERMS OF REFERENCE

<u>Preamble</u>

The Nominations Committee is an ad-hoc Committee of the Board of Weightlifting Canada Haltérophilie (WCH). It shall provide assistance in the recruitment process and filling vacancies on the WCH Board of Directors.

Mandate

Ensure, on an as-needed basis, that the WCH Board of Directors is composed of qualified and skilled persons capable of, and committed to, providing effective governance leadership to WCH.

Scope

To invite expressions of interest for nominations to the WCH Board of Directors.

The Nominations Committee will perform the following key duties:

- Determine interest of current eligible Directors in serving for a future term
- Issue a call for expressions of interest with the assistance of the Secretary/Treasurer of the organization
- Work collaboratively to review nominations as required
- research the background of potential candidates and to approach potential candidates with respect to their interest in serving on the WCH Board
- Review and confirm / validate information provided on the expression of interest from interested parties, whether by email, phone, and/or cross-referencing publicly available information
- consider the findings of the confirmation / validation of findings when making recommendations to the Board of Directors.
- Determine suitability of individual candidates based on current needs, including current Directors eligible for second term if applicable
- Review the eligibility requirements as outlined in the by-laws
- Identify a slate of individuals that will satisfy the desired outcomes
- Report to Board with a recommended slate
- Avoid conflicts of interest to the extent possible by assigning review of candidates to Committee members with the least personal connection to the individual candidates
- Ensure that the following guiding principles for Board Composition are reflected in the recommendations:
 - o A mix of skills and expertise that is reflective of current needs and priorities
 - Gender balance, cultural diversity and linguistic duality
 - o General understanding of the fiduciary responsibilities

The Committee is advisory only and makes recommendations to the Board of Directors, which has final decision-making authority.

Frequency of Meetings

The Committee will meet by telephone or in person, as required. Meetings will be at the call of the Committee Chair.

Decision Making

Recommendations of the Committee will be reached through consensus. If a Committee member disagrees with other Committee or abstains from making a recommendation, then recommendations will be made by majority decision.

Appointment

The composition will include the President and at least 2 other individuals. The Committee may consult beyond its members.

Term

The Committee will be appointed on an ad-hoc basis where Board vacancies exist. The Committee will cease to exist when a formal recommendation is made to the Board of Directors for confirmation of eligible candidates. Committee members may serve repeatedly upon request.
